Drawing with chalk

- Ensure each child has their own stick of chalk and encourage them to draw pictures, shapes, or patterns on the ground. Let their imagination flow.
- Ask them to describe their drawings.
- Can they find other materials to add to their pictures, for example twigs, leaves or flowers?
- Can their drawings be made into a game? Could they play a form of Pictionary where you suggest a picture to draw and others must guess what it is? What about hopscotch or noughts and crosses?
- If there is potential for a game what can you do to enhance it? Can you join in?
- Remember to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds when you go back indoors.
