

Drawing with chalk gets children outdoors and using their imagination. And doesn't leave a mess inside!

- Give each child a stick of chalk and let their imagination flow! Encourage them to draw pictures, shapes or patterns.
- Ask them to describe their drawings.
- Can they find other materials to add to their pictures? For example, leaves could become 'ears', twigs could be 'arms', a flower could be the sun.
- Can their drawings be made into a game?
  What about hopscotch, noughts and crosses, or even Pictionary?
